This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in the upper 2 bands in NAPLAN Year 3 reading to 40%
- Improve the NAPLAN mean score in Years 3 and 5 numeracy to be statistically similar to the Nation
- Increase the percentage of students achieving above the National Minimum Standard in Years 3 and 5 to 100%


Our strategy will be to

- Utilise data analysis processes to identify students for targeted intervention and extension in reading and numeracy and to improve school wide pedagogy
- Develop support plans for students who do not meet the National Minimum Standard in literacy and/or numeracy
- Implement comprehensive literacy and numeracy programs which embed a consistent language and approach across the early years
- Use skilled staff and specialists to deliver targeted programs to support students in literacy and numeracy

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Continue to engage a Head of Student Learning to lead and support teachers in data analysis processes, utilization of data for targeted intervention	\$50 000
• Employ and train teacher aides to support classroom teachers to differentiate for their students and deliver targeted and specialist programs	\$120 000
• Employ a Speech Pathology Teacher for an additional day to deliver targeted intervention programs in Prep and Year 1	\$17 022.90
• Provide resources and professional development to support our school's signature programs and reading framework	\$104 774.10
• Employ an early years intervention teacher to support students through targeted intervention programs and Reading Recovery	\$80 000
