This funding will be used to

- Increase percentage of students achieving A-C in English and Maths to 15% A, 30% B, 45% C in Years 1-6.
- Ensure every student who does not meet the school's P-2 Reading benchmarks is identified and is engaged in targeted intervention and support.
- Ensure every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year-level achievement standard in English.

- Deepen teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptors and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for teacher collaboration in planning, assessment and moderation.
